

MILLINUP ROAD — WIDENING

Petition

HON MATT BENSON-LIDHOLM (South West) [10.02 am]: I present a petition containing 313 signatures couched in the following terms —

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned residents of Western Australia are opposed to the Shire of Plantagenet's proposal to widen Millinup road from six metres to twelve metres.

Your petitioners therefore respectfully request the Legislative Council to recommend the following conditions be adhered to by the Shire of Plantagenet.

- 1. Retain the existing six metre width, as per minimum requirement for a rural unsealed road.**
- 2. To actively protect all designated flora roads within the shire by providing signage**
- 3. To improve road safety with appropriate road signage**
- 4. To provide 2 lay-by's of minimum size for tourists to stop, with appropriate road signage.**

And your petitioners as in duty bound will ever pray.
