 - (a) who is the provider or providers;
 - (b) what is the cost of this course to students; and
 - (c) is the private provider using drones supplied by South Regional TAFE in these courses?
- (3) If yes to (2)(c), what are the contractual arrangements between South Regional TAFE and the private provider for the use of these drones?
