MAYLANDS BOATYARD PTY LTD, LEASE

193. Hon. C.L. Edwardes to the Minister for the Environment and Heritage

I refer the Minister to the lease between the Western Australian Planning Commission and the Maylands Boatyard Pty Ltd dated July 1987, and ask: -

- (a) has approval been sought, from the Swan River Management Authority, for the installation of a refuelling jetty at the Maylands Boatyard;
- (b) if so, by whom and when;
- (c) has approval been granted by the Swan River Management Authority; and
- (d) if no approval has been sought, or granted, what action will the Swan River Management Authority take to limit any potential damage to the Swan River?

Dr J.M. EDWARDS replied:

- (a) No. The Swan River Trust has not received an application for the approval of the installation for a refuelling jetty at the Maylands Boatyard.
- (b) Not applicable.
- (c) Not applicable.
- (d) As there is no refuelling jetty at Maylands Boatyard the Swan River Trust does not need to take action. However should the Trust receive an application, it will be subject to the assessment process under the Swan River Trust Act 1988. This will include potential impacts on the Swan River.
