- What is the average proportion of students in Western Australian primary schools state wide that are in the care of the CEO of the Department of Child Protection?
- (4) What is the average proportion of students in Western Australian primary schools state wide that are subject to child protection notifications?

Ms A.R. Mitchell replied:

(1) The Department for Child Protection and Family Support's records indicate that, as at 1 January 2015, there are 49 children in care at primary schools in Broome.
