BUNBURY HOSPITAL, PSYCHIATRIC UNIT

- 732. Hon Barry House to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Health
- (1) Can the Minister assure South West residents that the Psychiatric Unit of the Bunbury Hospital is fully staffed and able to handle any call for help?
- (2) If not, why not?
- (3) When will the unit be fully staffed and fully operational?
- What is the current staffing level and what is the required staffing level to enable the Psychiatric Unit to operate to capacity?
- (5) What were the staffing levels at the unit in -
 - (a) 1998;
 - (b) 2000; and
 - (c) 2002?
- (6) How many people sought admission to the unit in -
 - (a) 1998;
 - (b) 2000; and
 - (c) 2002?
- (7) How many were turned away, or forced to travel to Perth for treatment?
- (8) Why did the Government offer only a 12 month contract to an established, competent and well-known health professional to work in Bunbury when its labour relations policy encourages long-term, awards-based employment in the City?

Hon LJILJANNA RAVLICH replied:

- 1. The unit is not fully staffed at present. Patient management is determined and appropriate referral takes place to Perth based on available resources and patient acuity.
- 2. The key factor inhibiting the full staffing and operation of the unit has been the availability of psychiatrists and supporting medical staff.
- 3. The unit can be fully operational when there are sufficient psychiatrists to cover the on duty and on call requirements for the unit.
- 4. The current staffing level is: 1 FTE Psychiatrist, 13 FTE Nursing, 1 Nurse Therapist, 1 OT Assistant. Full operational staffing will require the availability of an additional Psychiatrist to participate in the on call roster; 1 FTE Medical Officer, 6 FTE Nurses, 1 Social Worker, 1 Occupational Therapist and 0.5 Clinical Psychologist is required to make the unit fully operational

 - (b) 2000 25.94 FTE
 - (c) 2002 26.59 FTE
- 6. (a) N/a not operational
 - (b) 2000 314 Admissions
 - (c) 2002 175 Admissions
- 7. Current information systems are unable to provide accurate data on this question
- 8. No 12 month contract of service has been issued from Bunbury.
