

INQUIRIES, TERMS OF REFERENCE, BUDGETS, MEMBERSHIP AND REPORTS

1531. Mr Graham to the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure

Since 10 Feb 2001 -

- (a) how many inquiries chaired by Members of Parliament have been instigated in the Minister's areas of portfolio responsibility;
- (b) what are the terms of reference of each inquiry;
- (c) does each inquiry have its own budget;
- (d) if the answer to (c) is yes, how much is the budget for each inquiry;
- (e) if the answer to (c) is no, how are the costs of each inquiry being met, and what is the cost of each inquiry;
- (f) who is the chair of each inquiry;
- (g) are any other Members of Parliament involved with the inquiry;
- (h) if the answer to (g) is yes, which particular members are involved;
- (i) on what date is each inquiry required to report;
- (j) will the reports of each inquiry be made public;
- (k) if the answer to (j) is yes, how will each inquiry report be released to the public;
- (l) if the answer to (j) is no, what are the reasons for not releasing the reports of each inquiry?
