RAILWAY STATIONS, VEHICLE THEFT FROM CAR PARKS

711. Hon. C.L. Edwardes to the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure

I refer to the Minister's announcement that more than 200 vehicles were stolen from train car parks in the past financial year and ask -

- (a) how many of these were from -
 - (i) Whitfords; and
 - (ii) Warwick;
- (b) how many vehicles currently park at -
 - (i) Whitfords; and
 - (ii) Warwick,

on a daily or weekly basis; and

- (c) what are the current costs of parking at -
 - (i) Whitfords; and
 - (ii) Warwick?

Ms A.J. MacTIERNAN replied:

- (a) (i) Whitfords: 22 vehicles stolen.
 - (ii) Warwick: 31 vehicles stolen.
- (b) (i) Whitfords has 730 bays.
 - (ii) Warwick has 973 bays.

Both carparks are at full capacity on weekdays.

- (c) (i) At Whitfords no fee is charged for parking.
 - (ii) Warwick has a secure parking area where a fee is charged. That fee is currently \$1.65 per day or part thereof.
