Petition

MR A.P. O'GORMAN (Joondalup) [9.01 am]: I present a petition with 63 signatures, which reads as follows—

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned, are suffering from the constant volume of traffic noise along Burns Beach Rd and it is affecting the health and lifestyle of our families. We feel that the government has not done enough to assist with this problem and know there is more they can do.

Now we ask the Legislative Assembly to (1) extend the Mitchell Freeway north, connecting it to Neerabup Road, which will take much of the heavy traffic off Burns Beach Road, and (2) ensure adequate noise reduction treatments are placed along the southern side of Burns Beach Road, Joondalup, between Joondalup Drive and the Mitchell Freeway, to minimise traffic noise and dust.
