## LOTTERIES COMMISSION, ADVERTISING CONTRACT

- 378. Mr RIEBELING to the Minister representing the Minister for Racing and Gaming:
- (1) Will the Minister confirm that the advertising contract from the Lotteries Commission is up for renewal?
- (2) On what date were tenders sought?
- (3) How many tenders were received?
- (4) What is the approximate value of the contract?
- (5) If the contract has been awarded -
  - (a) who was it awarded to;
  - (b) on what date;
  - (c) what is the expiry date; and
  - (d) what was the value of the contract?
- (6) If the contract has not been awarded, when will it be awarded?

## Mr COWAN replied:

(1) The Lotteries Commission advertising contract is due for renewal.

(2) Tender document released - 9 June 2000
Briefing session - 16 June 2000
Lodgement of tenders - 30 June 2000

- (3) Two tenders were received.
- (4) The contract is for a 5 year period and the value is:

Media - \$4.9 million per annum [approximately]
Production - \$1.6 million per annum [approximately]

- (5) The contract has not yet been awarded
- (6) Lotteries Commission Board Approval 23 August 2000 State Tenders Committee consideration approval - 31 August 2000 Contract commencement date - 1 October 2000
