- 5161. Ms M.J. Davies to the Treasurer:
- (1) I refer to the State Government's Voluntary Targeted Separation Scheme (VTSS), and I ask?
- (2) What is the current status of the VTSS?
- (3) What is the total number of separations made to date?
- (4) Please list position titles, a brief job description and salary level for each former employee, broken down by agency, that has accepted a separation under the VTSS in (3)?
- (5) Please provide associated payout costs for each of these separations?
- (6) Since the separations have occurred, please list new positions created in each agency, including the position titles?
- (7) When did advertising for each of the positions in (6) commence?

Mr B.S. Wyatt replied:

(1)

- (2) A total of 2,556 separations (85%) of the 3,000 target for the VTSS have been achieved to date and with a further 390 separations expected as a result of the transition to the Commonwealth-run National Disability Insurance Scheme. The VTSS is on track to deliver 2,946 separations or 98% of the original target by 30 June 2022.
 - The VTSS program is projected to achieve a net saving of \$527 million over the period 2017–18 to 2022–23 to net debt.
