

WORKING PARTIES, TERMS OF REFERENCE, BUDGETS, MEMBERSHIP AND REPORTS

1555. Mr Graham to the Attorney General; Minister for Justice and Legal Affairs; Electoral Affairs; Peel and the South West

Since 10 Feb 2001 -

- (a) how many working parties chaired by Members of Parliament have been instigated in the Attorney General's areas of portfolio responsibility;
- (b) what are the terms of reference of each working party;
- (c) does each working party have its own budget;
- (d) if the answer to (c) is yes, how much is the budget for each working party;
- (e) if the answer to (c) is no, how are the costs of each working party being met, and what is the cost of each working party;
- (f) on what date is each working party required to report;
- (g) who is the chair of each working party;
- (h) are any other Members of Parliament involved with the working party;
- (i) if the answer to (h) is yes which particular members are involved;
- (j) will the reports of each working party be made public;
- (k) if the answer to (j) is yes, how will each inquiry report be released to the public; and
- (l) if the answer to (j) is no, what are the reasons for not releasing the reports of each working

party?
