PARKERVILLE CHILDREN'S HOME, FUNDING

- 835. Mr RIPPER to the Minister for Family and Children's Services:
- (1) Is the Minister aware of complaints about activities associated with young people staying at the Parkerville Children's Home in Pontiac Avenue, Cloverdale?
- (2) What funding does the Family and Children's Services Department give to the Pontiac Avenue operation?
- (3) Is funding advanced on the condition that the agency prevents problems for neighbours arising from the agency's operation?
- (4) If not, why not?
- (5) What action has the Department taken to ensure neighbours are not disturbed by residents of this agency?

- (3)-(4) No, Parkerville Children's Home receives funds to provide 6 medium to long term placements for children/young people aged 14 to 17 years. Children and young people are to receive quality care in a safe supportive environment, relationships with their families are maintained and strengthened, provided their safety and well being is not compromised, and the children and young people develop and maintain skills and relationships conducive to stable living arrangements in the community.
