389. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

- (1) Is the Minister for Transport aware of any threats of flooding or erosion or other damage risks associated with the extent of damage to the groyne that has been washed away near the convergence of Collie, Brunswick and Preston Rivers in the Leschenault Estuary?
- (2) Is restoration work required to restore the groyne and the area around The Cut before winter to prevent flooding and further damage?

Hon JIM CHOWN replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question.

- (1) Yes.
- Yes. The Department of Transport intends to implement an urgent interim repair to the damaged section of the rock structure and these works are expected to commence over the next two weeks.
