## BANKSIA HILL DETENTION CENTRE — UNIT 18 DETAINEES — SUICIDE ATTEMPTS AND SELF-HARM

# 1111. Hon PETER COLLIER to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Corrective Services:

- (1) On what date were the juveniles from Banksia Hill Detention Centre, or BHDC, first transferred to unit 18, Casuarina Prison?
- (2) Since the date referred to in (1) to today, how many juveniles have been transferred from BHDC to unit 18, Casuarina Prison?
- (3) How many of the juveniles referred to in (2) have attempted self-harm or suicide since being transferred to unit 18, Casuarina Prison?

### Hon MATTHEW SWINBOURN replied:

I thank the member for some notice of the question. The following information is provided to me by the Minister for Corrective Services.

- (1) It was on 20 July 2022.
- (2) There were 33 distinct young people.
- (3) The number of distinct young people who have attempted self-harm or suicide since their first transfer to unit 18 of Casuarina Prison is in tabular form. I seek leave to have the response incorporated into *Hansard*.

| Incident Occurrence           | Number of Young People |
|-------------------------------|------------------------|
| Attempted Suicide             | 7                      |
| Self-Harm - Serious           | 2                      |
| Self-Harm - Minor             | 18                     |
| Total (Distinct Young People) | 18                     |

**N.B.** The numbers in the table do not add up to the overall total – this is because some individuals involved are included in more than one self-harm / attempted suicide category.
