366. Hon C L Edwardes to the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure

I refer to the proposed redevelopment of the Leighton Marshalling yards, and *The West Australian* article dated 1 March 2001, and ask -

- (a) did the Minister ask the Ministry of Planning for a report on the development, and, if so, upon what date;
- (b) has that report been received;
- (c) if so, would the Minister please table a copy;
- (d) if not, why not;
- (e) if so, what is the process that you will now undertake to make a decision on this site?

Ms MacTIERNAN replied:

- (a) Yes. In February 2001.
- (b) Yes.
- (c) No.
- (d) The report does not fully set out information relevant to this matter.
- (e) I am convening a 2001 Freight Planning Congress, to be held in late October this year, which may have implications for planning of this site arising from possible changes to regional transport route requirements. I therefore intend to further consider the relevant issues later this year.
