

WORKSAFE WA, PROHIBITION NOTICES, WORK ORDERS AND PROSECUTIONS

For each month in the 1999-2000 year involving the WorkSafe inspectorate -

- (a) how many individual workplaces were visited by WorkSafe inspectors;
- (b) how many workplaces had prohibition notices issued to them;
- (c) what was the total number of prohibition notices issued by WorkSafe inspectors;
- (d) what was the number of workplaces which had work orders issued for them;
- (e) what was the total number of work orders issued by WorkSafe inspectors;
- (f) what was the number of motor vehicles rostered as available for WorkSafe inspectors; and
- (g) what was the number of prosecutions initiated by WorkSafe?
