DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND INFRASTRUCTURE, ENFORCEMENT OF LEASE CONDITIONS

727. Hon. C.L. Edwardes to the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure

I refer the Minister to the Department of Planning and Infrastructure's responsibility for enforcement of lease conditions and ask: -

- (a) how many leases, in the metropolitan area, is the Department for Planning and Infrastructure the lessor for;
- (b) on how many occasions has the Office of the Ombudsman investigated the enforcement of lease conditions by the Department of Planning and Infrastructure and to which leases do these investigations refer;
- (c) what was the reason for each investigation;
- (d) what was the outcome of each investigation; and
- (e) have any changes been recommended in the way the Department of Planning and Infrastructure deals with and enforces lease conditions?

Ms A.J. MacTIERNAN replied:

The breadth of the information being sought by the Member would take considerable resources to collate. I am not prepared to reallocate agency resources to meet this request. If there is a specific lease that the Member is concerned with, the Member is requested to ask a question on that particular lease.
