## 479. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the minister's advice that Main Roads is investigating alternative arrangement options to allow road train drivers to assemble and disassemble at the Roelands road train assembly area after dark.

- (1) What alternative options are being investigated?
- (2) Who is being consulted about these options?
- (3) Does the minister place any priority on resolving this situation quickly; and, if not, why not?
- (4) If yes, when will it be resolved?

- (1) Main Roads is investigating a proposal to extend the road train access.
- (2) Various stakeholders, including industry, are being consulted.
