Question: Mrs Edwardes asked whether the minister could confirm the FTE figures for last year in the Budget Statements.

Answer: According to the June 30, 2001 salary analysis (see below), the numbers were as follows:

Therefore the answer is that the number of FTEs referred to in the Budget Statements relates to the number used, not necessarily the number of positions allocated or created. In the 2000-01 Budget Statements, the total number of FTE Employed was 281,compared with the FTE estimate of 257.
