**135. Hon MATT BENSON-LIDHOLM to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Housing and Works:**

I refer to the commonwealth–state agreement to construct 75 homes in remote Aboriginal communities by 30 June 2010.

- (1) How many of these houses are constructed and connected to all necessary services such as power and water?
- (2) How many of these houses are occupied?
- (3) Will all of the 75 houses be built and serviced by 30 June 2010?
- (4) If no to (3), how many are expected to be built and serviced by 30 June?
- (5) What are the addresses of the houses that have been built but not yet had services connected?
