## POLICE — SALARIES AND WAGES

271. Hon Tjorn Sibma to the minister representing the Minister for Police:

For each category/classification of Western Australian Police (WAPOL) officer can the Minister provide for the financial years 2016–17 to 2020–21 (inclusive), details regarding:

- (a) the total WAPOL salaries and wages bill per annum at current levels (2016–17) amended to reflect CPI fluctuations;
- (b) the total WAPOL salaries and wages bill per annum reflecting the implementation of the Government's wages policy capping pay rises to \$1000 per annum; and
- (c) the total WAPOL salaries and wages bill per annum reflecting the implementation of the original 1.5% pay increase pledged during the election?

## Hon Stephen Dawson replied:

(a) The CPI estimates used are reflective of the 2017–18 Budget Estimates (Budget Paper No. 3 – Economic and Fiscal Outlook, Page 3), extracted as below:
