256. Hon C L Edwardes to the Minister for the Environment and Heritage; Water Resources

For each Department or Agency under the Minister's control –

- (b) what is the annual salaries and wages budget exclusive of Workers Compensation and Superannuation for the temporary and contract positions?

Dr EDWARDS replied:

The Department of Conservation and Land Management:

- (a) 435
- (b) \$11,244,221

The Department of Environmental Protection:

As no 'as at' date was specified for this question, the DEP has used the date 31 May 2001

- (a) 55
- (b) \$1, 702,885.90

The Heritage Council of Western Australia:

- (a) Two (2)
- (b) \$64,284

The Office of Water Regulation:

- (a) 7 staff (5.3 FTE) Temporary or Contract positions, including two officers on secondment from other agencies.
- (b) \$272,000

The Water and Rivers Commission:

- (a) 68.
- (b) \$2,464,306.00

The Water Corporation:

- (a) As at 1 May 2001 there were 243 employees on fixed term contracts. These include casuals and apprentices.
- (b) The Water Corporation does not hold labour budgets based on the type or status of positions.

The Perth Zoological Gardens:

b) \$1,056,101

The Botanic Gardens and Parks Authority:

- (b) \$1.2 Million.
