## 334. Hon MATT BENSON-LIDHOLM to the minister representing the Minister for Education:

I refer to recent reports from the Isolated Children's Parents' Association state conference regarding facilities at Esperance Residential College.

- (1) How many students are currently housed at Esperance Residential College?
- Given that the college's ablution block and dining room are considered inadequate for all students and that years 11 and 12 students are still in dormitory style accommodation, when will the government take steps to improve conditions for students at Esperance Residential College?
