

GROYNE CONSTRUCTION PROGRAMS, NORTH WEST

1128. Mr L. Graham to the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure

I refer to the recent announcement that the State Government will provide \$1million to be used to build three groynes at Quinns Beach, and I ask -

- (a) how much is to be spent on similar programs in the North West of the State;
- (b) in which towns and communities will the funds be spent;
- (c) who will be responsible for administering the funds; and
- (d) when will the programs commence operation in each town referred to above?

Ms A.J. MacTIERNAN replied:

- (a)-(d) The project at Quinns Beach is to counter a serious coastal erosion problem. No North West local government authorities are currently seeking assistance with managing coastal erosion.
