

WESTERN POWER — REGIONAL CONSUMERS

933. Hon Dr Steve Thomas to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Energy:

I refer to Western Power's supply allocation of 32 Amps for single phase rural residential properties in Western Australia versus 63 Amps for cities and towns in Western Australia, and I ask how much electricity do regional consumers of energy use compared to their metropolitan counterparts?

**Hon Matthew Swinbourn replied:**

Western Power advises the following daily average electricity consumption for the 2022 Financial Year.

	<b>Average daily consumption (kWh)</b>
<b>Metro</b>	12.11
<b>Regional</b>	12.65

It is important to note that these figures are averages and that individual electricity consumption will vary between customers in both metropolitan and regional areas.
