## VASSE MIDDLE SCHOOL, PLANS

- 1837. Hon Barry House to the Minister for Education and Training
- (1) What are the current plans for the proposed Vasse Middle School?
- (2) Will the school open in February 2007 as previously indicated?
- (3) If not, why not?
- (4) Are there any environmental concerns linked to building the school on former agricultural land?
- (5) If yes to (4), what are these concerns and what steps are being taken to address them?

## Hon LJILJANNA RAVLICH replied:

- (1) Architects, Hassell Pty Ltd, were appointed in November 2004, and have completed the master plan for the site and are well advanced with schematic design.
- (2) No.
- (3) There are subdivisional requirements which the Developer has yet to meet, therefore it is unlikely that the site will be available until early 2006 and the project tender is not expected to go out until March 2006. The developer has been unable to confirm that services (the sewer in particular) will be available to the site by 2007.
- (4) Yes.
- (5) Early indications of residual pesticide contamination on the site are being investigated but it is not expected to be a material issue.
