

MOTORCYCLE SAFETY REVIEW GROUP

135. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the Attorney General representing the Minister for Police:

- (1) Has the Motorcycle Safety Review Group concluded its report?
- (2) If yes to (1), what conclusions did the group reach about the rate of death and serious injury amongst motorcycle riders aged 85 years and older?
- (3) Did the group make recommendations about whether mandatory aged-based practical driving assessments should be removed for motorcyclists in line with the removal of these tests for other licence holders?
- (4) If no to (1), when will the report be concluded and made public?
