LEEUWIN-NATURALISTE NATIONAL PARK, ENTRY FEES

247. Hon BARRY HOUSE to the minister representing the Minister for the Environment and Heritage:

- (1) What funds were collected by the Department of Conservation and Land Management from entry fees into the Leeuwin-Naturaliste National Park -
 - (a) between inception and abolition;
 - (b) collected by the Shires of Busselton and Augusta-Margaret River as a result of the agreement with the local authorities; and
 - (c) other sources?
- (2) With the recent abolition of these fees, from where will CALM derive the equivalent funds for its required work in the Leeuwin-Naturaliste National Park?
