

GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES, CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND CHIEF
EMPLOYEE POSITIONS

181. Hon C L Edwardes to the Premier; Minister for Public Sector Management; Federal Affairs; Science; Citizenship and Multicultural Interests

As at 1 May 2001, for departments, agencies and statutory authorities under the control of the Premier, that are Senior Executive Service Organisations (as defined by the Public Sector Management Act 1994), will the Premier advise -

- (a) the number of Chief Executive Officer and/or Chief Employee positions;
- (b) for each of these positions -
 - (i) the title of the position;
 - (ii) the name of the department, agency or statutory authority;
 - (iii) the annual salary for the position;
 - (iv) the classification of the position;
 - (v) the name of the substantive occupant of the position;
 - (vi) whether the position is full-time or part-time;
 - (vii) the date the substantive occupant was appointed to the position;
 - (viii) the start and finish date of the substantive occupant's contract for the position;
 - (ix) the classification of the substantive occupant;
 - (x) does the substantive occupant have right of return to the public sector; and
 - (xi) where the position is vacant, the name of the officer acting in that position?

Dr GALLOP replied:

- (a) There are no Senior Executive Service Organisations, as defined by the Public Sector Management Act 1994, under the control of the Premier.
