

ENVIRONMENT — KARRI AND MARRI REGROWTH THINNING

3063. Hon Diane Evers to the minister representing the Minister for Forestry:

Regarding the thinning of karri and marri regrowth, in the year 2019, I ask:

 - (v) other grade marri sawlogs (please specify);
 - (vi) marri chip logs; and
 - (vii) other (please specify); and
- (d) what was the volume estimated to be available of:
 - (i) first and second grade karri sawlogs;
 - (ii) other grade karri sawlogs;
 - (iii) karri chip logs; and
 - (iv) marri logs?
