

GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES, MINISTERIAL INVOLVEMENT IN ADVERTISING,  
SELECTION AND CONDITIONS OF STAFF

1287. Hon C.L. Edwardes to the Minister for Education; Sport and Recreation; Indigenous Affairs

In the context of sections 8 and 105 (1) of the Public Sector Management Act 1994 I ask -

- (a) has the Minister or any of the Minister's staff, in the Minister's office, in all of his portfolio responsibilities, been in any way involved in the selection, appointment, transfer, secondment, classification, remuneration, redeployment or termination, of an individual employee by way of direction or otherwise;
- (b) has the Minister or any of the Minister's staff, in the Minister's office, in all of his portfolio responsibilities been in any way involved in the classification of a particular office, post or position by way of direction or otherwise; and
- (c) has the Minister or any of the Minister's staff, in the Minister's office, in all of his portfolio responsibilities directed, discussed or attempted to influence the advertising or calling for expressions of interest of any position?
