

CORONIAL PROCESSES — LETTER TO ATTORNEY GENERAL

I thank the member for some notice of the question. I provide the following response on behalf of the Attorney General.

- (1)–(4) Mr Cameron has written to the Attorney General and raised matters of significance concerning a reportable death and coronial process. The matters Mr Cameron raised are being given careful consideration by the Department of Justice and a response will be provided to Mr Cameron as soon as practicable.
