Question: Mr M.P. Whitely asked the parliamentary secretary to identify the staff turnover at Redress WA, and the proportion of staff who have left the service, particularly in the past year?

Answer: Actual staff turnover for Redress WA, over the period June 2009 to June 2010 is 13 per cent.

[Supplementary Information No A24.]

Question: Mr A.P. O'Gorman referred to the final dot point on page 719 of the Budget Statements about volunteering, and asked the parliamentary secretary to indicate what contribution the government is making to Volunteering WA and what the increase was from last year to this year.

Answer: The contribution to Volunteering WA in 2010-11 is \$421 056. There are two subprograms – one for \$283 200 and the second for \$137 856.

In 2009-10, the contribution to Volunteerig WA for these programs was \$274 685 and \$133 711, totalling an overall funding amount of \$408 398. The total funding increase is \$12 660.
