I refer to reserve 24574 Kalgoorlie and ask -

- (1) What environmental health concerns caused by mining activities in the vicinity of the reserve led to the closure of the reserve for habitation?
- (2) When was the reserve closed for habitation?
- (3) Were any people living on the reserve at the time of, or immediately before, its closure for habitation?
- (4) If yes -
 - (a) were the inhabitants of the reserve relocated; and
 - (b) where were they relocated?
- (5) Did the mining leaseholders, Dallhold Investments Pty Ltd and others, assist with the cost of relocation?
- (6) If yes, were the leaseholders under any legal or contractual obligations, or party to any agreement with the Aboriginal Lands Trust and the Aboriginal Affairs Planning Authority, to contribute to the cost of relocation?
