ANTI-CORRUPTION COMMISSION, TELEPHONE INTERCEPTION EQUIPMENT

690. Hon DERRICK TOMLINSON to the Minister for Housing and Works:

- (1) Did the State Supply Commission call for tenders for the supply of telephone interception equipment for the former Anti-Corruption Commission?
- (2) If yes, how many tenders were received?
- (3) Who evaluated those tenders?
- (4) Which tender was accepted?
- (5) Did the contract for supply include maintenance?
- (6) What was the total value of the contract for supply and maintenance?

Hon NICK GRIFFITHS replied:

I thank Hon Derrick Tomlinson for some notice of this question.

(1)-(6) The State Supply Commission did not call any tender for the supply of telephone interception equipment on behalf of the former Anti-Corruption Commission. The State Supply Commission does not call tenders on behalf of any public authority under the State Supply Commission Act 1991.
