- (1) I refer to the statement made by the Vasse ALP candidate that 'health funding in Vasse would be increased' and ask will the Minister honour this commitment to meet the rapidly expanding needs of Vasse?
- (2) If yes, what new and existing services will benefit from the increased funding?
