To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned, say that plans for upgrading the existing clubroom building of the Morley/Noranda Recreation Club must be brought forward as a matter of urgency. The Morley/Noranda Recreation Club is a popular and important hub for children, families and seniors in the community and is experiencing record numbers of new membership applications. The current facilities are in some state of disrepair and unable to cater for the growing needs of the club and functions being hosted within the building.

Now we ask the Legislative Assembly to direct the Minister for Sports and Recreation to approve funding of \$800,000 for this project, which is expected to take place in three stages of construction. A detailed proposal plan exists.
