

UNIT 4, 31 VICTORIA STREET, BUNBURY — HON ADELE FARINA

288. Hon NIGEL HALLETT to the Leader of the House representing the Premier:

- (1) Does the Department of the Premier and Cabinet lease the property at the complex at 31 Victoria Street, Bunbury?
- (2) When did the negotiations to lease this office space commence?
- (3) When did this lease commence and when does it expire?
- (4) If the office is leased to a member of Parliament, please advise which member.
- (5) What is the total cost per annum of the lease and outgoing expenses?
- (6) What was the cost of the office fit-out?
- (7) Has the member commenced working out of the office; and, if not, when will this occur?
- (8) Where is the member's current office and what is the total cost of the current per annum lease and outgoing expenses?

Hon NORMAN MOORE replied:

I thank the member for some notice of this question; it is an interesting one, actually.

- (1) Yes, Unit 4, 31 Victoria Street, Bunbury.
- (2) September 2007.
- (3) The lease commenced on 15 February 2008 and is due to expire on 15 February 2014.
- (4) Yes, Hon Adele Farina MLC, member for South West.
- (5) It is \$59 822.
- (6) It was \$102 000; however, the honourable member has now advised that she requires additional work to be completed.
- (7) No. The issue of additional work is still being addressed. The honourable member has advised that she will not move in until the additional works are completed.
- (8) Unit 3, 69 Duchess Street, Busselton; \$33 043.50 per annum.
