798. Hon RICK MAZZA to the Minister for Environment:

I refer to an article in today's *The West Australian* titled "Frack inquiry finished", and my questions of 12 September 2017 and 10 May 2018 regarding that inquiry.

- (1) When will the report be made public?
- (2) Can the minister now advise the total cost of this additional scientific inquiry?
- (3) If no to (2), why not?
- (4) Can the minister advise the number of days that the inquirers committed to the inquiry?
- (5) If no to (4), why not?
- (6) Will this government implement further inquiries into fracking?

Hon STEPHEN DAWSON replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question.

- (1) The report will be made public on the inquiry website once the government has had time to consider its findings and recommendations and formulate a response.
- (2) Yes. The inquiry cost is currently being finalised. It is estimated to be less than \$450 000.
- (3) Not applicable.
- (4) Yes. The inquirers committed approximately 200 days to the inquiry.
- (5) Not applicable.
- (6) The government will not make any decisions until it has read the report and considered the findings and recommendations.
