

TEACHERS APPOINTED TO NON-TEACHING POSITIONS

1673. Hon DERRICK TOMLINSON to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Education and Training:

How many qualified teachers employed by the Department of Education and Training are appointed to non-teaching positions outside government schools; that is, teachers assigned to head office or district offices as curriculum consultants, education officers and so on?

Hon GRAHAM GIFFARD replied:

The minister has provided the following answer -

There are 115. Additionally, 250 school psychologists, 41 primary extension and academic challenged - PEAC-teachers, and 141 music teachers working across more than one school are recorded as being attached to district education offices for administrative reasons.
