846. Hon. C.L. Edwardes to the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure

- (1) Will the Minister advise if any Government department or agency within the Minister's portfolio paid for membership to a club/association for a member of staff since February 2001?
- (2) If so, will the Minister provide -
 - (a) the name of the staff member;
 - (b) the name of the club/association; and
 - (c) the amount paid?
