714. Mr O'Gorman to the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure

I refer to the Labor Party's election commitment to provide additional parking for the rail users in the Joondalup electorate and ask will the Minister advise what steps have been taken to provide that additional parking?

Ms MacTIERNAN replied:

The City of Joondalup recently completed a study on parking at Joondalup City Centre, including the train station. Discussions are continuing between the City of Joondalup and Western Australian Government Railways Commission (WAGR) in relation to the parking issue with the study report being the basis for determining possible solutions to the railway commuter car parking problem.

An amount of \$1 million has been allocated for the provision of additional parking for rail users at Joondalup in the WAGR 2003/04 budget.
