

ALCOHOL-RELATED OFFENCES — REPORT

**503. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the Attorney General representing the Minister for Police:**

I refer the minister to tables 1 to 19 in the Meekatharra, Cue, Mt Magnet, Sandstone and Yalgoo report on alcohol-related harm and disorder presented by Western Australia Police to the Director of Liquor Licensing dated 2 April 2013. Of the alcohol-related offences referred to in these tables: how many individuals were involved in the years cited in each table; how many repeat offenders were there in each of those years for each table; what is the total of offences by repeat offenders in each year for each table; and, what postcodes were provided by the offenders as their usual place of residence, including the number of offenders per postcode?

**Hon MICHAEL MISCHIN replied:**
