- (1) How many full-time equivalents (FTEs) were in the State Public sector in February 2001?
- (2) How many full-time equivalents (FTEs) were in the State Public sector in February 2002?
- (3) How many full-time equivalents (FTEs) were in the State Public sector in February 2003?
- (4) For each of these years, how many of the FTEs were Senior Executive Service positions?

Dr G.I. GALLOP replied:

Full-time equivalents (FTEs) counts for the Western Australian State Public sector is collected quarterly in March, June, September and December of each year.

- (1) There were 88,016 full-time equivalents (FTEs) in the State Public sector in March 2001
- (2) There were 88,785 full-time equivalents (FTEs) in the State Public sector in March 2002
- (3) There were 89,290 full-time equivalents (FTEs) in the State Public sector in December 2002
- (4) Figures on the number of Senior Executive Service members are collected in January of each year. The following are the number of members for each year:
