MAYLANDS BOATYARD PTY LTD, LEASE

194. Hon. C.L. Edwardes to the Minister for the Environment and Heritage

I refer the Minister to the lease between the Western Australian Planning Commission and the Maylands Boatyard Pty Ltd dated July 1987, and ask: -

- (a) is EPA approval required for the installation of a refuelling jetty that may impact on the Swan River;
- (b) has approval been sought for a refuelling jetty at the Maylands Boatyard;
- (c) if so by whom and when;
- (d) has approval been granted for a refuelling jetty at the Maylands Boatyard, by the EPA; and
- (e) if no approval has been given, what action will the Department take?

Dr J.M. EDWARDS replied:

- (a) If it were likely that the proposal would result in a significant effect on the environment, the Swan River Trust would refer it to the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA). If the EPA considered that the proposal warranted assessment, as Minister for the Environment and Heritage I would determine whether the proposal may be implemented and under what conditions.
