

DENNY AVENUE LEVEL CROSSING — BUSINESS DISRUPTION

**525. Hon TJORN SIBMA to the Leader of the House representing the Minister for Transport:**

I refer to the minister's answer to question on notice 1335, stating that \$898 840.61 was paid to businesses as part of the Denny Avenue level crossing removal project.

- (1) Can the minister table the breakdown of those compensation payments?
- (2) How is this a full list of compensation payments given the minister's comments in *The West Australian* in relation to the Bayswater Traders Association that "a \$5 000 payment had already been made to 44 local businesses in recognition of the inevitable disruption around the major infrastructure project", and —
  - (a) who made the payments to the 44 local businesses;
  - (b) which were the 44 businesses that payments were made to;
  - (c) please table the criteria for eligibility for the \$5 000 payment; and
  - (d) are there similar payments across the METRONET program of works that the minister failed to disclose in question on notice 1335?
