Hon LJILJANNA RAVLICH replied:

- (1) Osborne Primary School opened in 1903.
- (2) The school has applied for a covered assembly area, administration upgrade and car park, and a library and toilet upgrade in the capital works priorities 2005-2006. Building Maintenance Priority (BMP) projects identified by Housing and Works for 2005/6 total \$209 342.
- (3) District education offices are finalising the capital works and maintenance assessments priorities to be funded from the forthcoming capital works program.
