176. Hon Sally Talbot to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Health:

- (1) Did Janssen–Cilag Pty Ltd run a drug trial at Fremantle Hospital?
- (2) If so, when and who approved it?
- (3) What drug was the drug trial for?
- (4) Did Janssen–Cilag Pty Ltd make payments to Fremantle Hospital for information?
- (5) If so, how much was the payment and for what information was the hospital paid?
- (6) How much funding was paid to Fremantle Hospital for each patient on the trial?
- (7) How was the funding disbursed and to whom?
- (8) Who made this disbursement decision?
- (9) How many of the participants in this trial were involuntary patients?
- (10) What were these patients told about the trial?
- (11) If so, what records were made?
- (12) Where are the records?
- (13) Were there any Serious Adverse Events arising in any patients at the time they were on the trial or any time after the drugs were stopped that could be related to the drugs the subject of the trial?
- (14) Who were all the internal and external referral sources for the trial (please provide details of companies/individuals)?

Hon Alyssa Hayden replied:

- (1) Janssen–Cilag has sponsored 17 clinical research trials at Fremantle Hospital between 1997 and July 2013.
