MUJA POWER STATIONS

1330. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the Leader of the House representing the Minister for Energy:

I refer to staff at the Muja power stations. What is the breakdown of staff at each station in terms of —

- (a) senior staff, including managers and subordinates;
- (b) office staff;
- (c) floor management staff—superintendents, foreman, supervisors, leading hands;
- (d) health and safety staff;
- (e) trades, including the categories of trades and how many in each category, including riggers; and
- (f) trades assistants and other semiskilled workers?

Hon PETER COLLIER replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question.

The breakdown of staff at the Muja power station has been provided differently from the question asked so that complete numbers are supplied. The total number is 313, with 40 at Muja AB and 273 at the rest of Muja power station. The information is in tabular form, so I seek leave to incorporate it into *Hansard*.
