- 4242. Mr D.J. Kelly to the Minister representing the Minister for Fisheries:
- (1) How many shark monitoring network receivers were serviced in: 2009/10, 2010/11, 2011/12, 2012/13, 2013/14 and 2014/15?
- (2) How many shark monitoring network receivers will be serviced in 2015/16, 2016/17 and 2017/18?

## Dr K.D. Hames replied:

(1) Servicing of each of the VR4 satellite receivers is required at least once a year. The number of VR4 receivers in service for the years 2009/10–2014/15 were:
